2. NATAC

The Nevada Airports Technical Advisory Committee (NATAC) met on November 10th to discuss the Nevada Fund for Aviation that was implemented by the State to assist the smaller airports throughout the state with matching funds for federal grants. There are various restrictions for an airport to be eligible to receive these funds; it cannot be a Part 139 airport, it cannot be located in a county with a population of 700,000 or more, it cannot be owned or controlled by the Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority, and it must be eligible to receive a federal grant. There are twenty one (21) GA airports throughout the state that currently meet this criteria. This year, thirteen (13) of the eligible airports received an FAA grant in 2015 and there is \$127,900 available in the Fund for Aviation. NATAC has recommended that the 13 airports each receive a 29.27% contribution toward their match for their FAA grant. NATAC makes recommendations for the distribution of the available funds and those

recommendations are submitted by NDOT Aviation to the NDOT Director, who then makes the final determination. Application for these funds is made at the conclusion of the project or when the final drawdown on the FAA grant has been made. Assuming the NDOT Director agrees with the NATAC recommendations, the Carson City Airport will receive \$2,927 from the Nevada Fund for Aviation to assist with the \$10,000 match for the 2015 FAA grant of \$150,000. Based on the schedule for the North Apron design, we will apply for the \$2,927 in April 2016.

3. FAA Fiscal Year 2016 AIP Target Deadlines

The FAA recently sent an email revising the schedule for the 2016 Airport Improvement Program:

Specifically, the date to submit a pre-application based on estimate was changed from January 31st to December 31st. The ACIP Meeting with the FAA at the Phoenix ADO office will be held on December 2nd. During that meeting, we expect confirmation from the FAA on the dollar amount that they will offer for the reconstruction of the North Apron in 2016. Therefore, we have sufficient time to submit the grant pre-application and should easily meet the December 31st deadline.
