Managers' Report

- Sheriff Response at the airport
 - On July 15, 2022 at around 7:00 PM I received a call from a distraught young man who thought his sister was being kidnapped at the airport. After working with the Sheriff's office to search the area they called back and let us know she was safe and off airport.
- Communication with multiple developers interested in building aircraft storage hangars
- Received notice from the FAA our grant application for terminal funding has been declined
 - The was not unexpected because Part 139 commercial airports are given priority
 - We will be eligible for applying annually until 2026
- At the request of a potential developer, I worked with Pubic Works to determine if a sewer line goes under the runway into the triangle.
 - After public works came out to the airport and did some testing, it was determined that there is an 8 inch sewer line that goes from near the Alpha runup pad under Alpha, the runway and taxiway Delta and into the triangle.

- There has been a noticeable increase in aircraft noise complaints
 - I have been working with Paul Hamilton to address each complaint and to develop a noise complaint form to better track the complaints
- The FAA did a site visit to introduce some new engineering and planning staff and give them a tour of the airport
- Rick Lee and I attended an NVPERS conference in town for training on the new system they are implementing for reporting
- We received our letter of acceptance of the final budget from the State
- The Carson City Board of Supervisors accepted our ACIP and all potential grant awards
- Aircraft Operations
 - The total aircraft operations for June were 2603 according to ADS-B data.
