SUBJECT: Carson Tahoe Executive, LLC Project

The Carson Tahoe Executive project will be processed through our Special Use Permit process. This process requires all City Departments with regulatory responsibility to review the detailed plans and obtain code compliance, or the project will not be approved. Once the project is approved, permits will be issued for the construction of the project and all related inspections.

The Carson Tahoe Executive project proposal will be required to meet all applicable 2018 International Fire Code, Carson City Fire Code Amendments, and the National Fire (NFPA) Codes in relegation of the Bulk fuel storage facility.

The truck-to-truck transfer will also be required to meet all applicable 2018 International Fire Code, Carson City Fire Code Amendments, and the National Fire Codes.

Carson City is a Consolidated Municipality. Under the Nevada Revised Statutes, section 477.010 "In a county other than one whose population is 100,000 or more **or** which has been converted into a consolidated municipality, the State Fire Marshal shall, upon request by a local government, delegate to the local government by interlocal agreement all or portion of the State Fire Marshals authority or duties"

Carson City is the Authority having jurisdiction within Carson City legal boundaries, that includes the Carson City Airport.
